Assistant Garden Designer Full time position

Main purpose of job

The Assistant Garden Designer will support the studio's senior designers to deliver a range of private landscape projects in the UK, USA and Europe. Under the guidance of a team of senior garden designers, and working alongside the full team on various elements of garden design and project management, the post holder will help develop an exciting range of landscape projects.

#### Main duties & responsibilities

- o Assist senior designers on all phases of project development with a focus on design development, adhering to agreed project schedule and workflow, and liaison with suppliers and contractors
- o Support senior designers on project research and help to specify materials for construction including sourcing materials & samples
- o Support senior designers in the production of design documents and project drawing sets, including support with final reviews before submitting to clients
- o Attend site visits to document existing site conditions and track construction progress
- o Assist in the preparation of graphical information for presentations, concept designs, detail designs and specification documents
- o Assist the senior team with client liaison and represent the company in meetings when required
- o Keep detailed records and information, including written notes, photographs and videos, in line with the company's project management system
- o Attend training as required to support continued career development (AMGD will regularly assess and measure completion of tasks and provide training where needed)
- Regular feedback will be gathered from across the AMGD team to assist development
